Large group presentation

Time: 30-45 mins

Small group / class workshops

Time: 30-45 mins

The focus moves to the students themselves, as Steve spends quality time with individual classes or small groups (up to 40 students) at a time. We explore all their hopes, dreams, barriers and areas they want help.

We capture all this information and leave you with a written profile on each student to build on over the school year.

Combination of above

Time: 60 mins

This 'all-inclusive' stand-alone session is a combination of Steve's main presentation, a Q&A and the small group workshop. Steve can offer a maximum of four over the course of a visit.

One-to-one time No time limit

Steve relishes the opportunity to meet with individual students (along with a parent/teacher) who would really benefit from that extra bit of personal inspiration. They may be gifted and talented, have SEN, maybe low self-esteem, or need some inspiration prior to exams.

Welcome to Steve's world

Time: 45-75 mins

On come the blindfolds, as Steve teaches your students to play blind football or cricket (he's won England caps for both!) Tremendous fun, teamwork and trust are paramount.

Total visit up to 3 hours
